DISPLAY OF FIREWORKS "PERMITS"

The issuance of permits for the display of fireworks shall be based upon the following requirements:

1. Compliance with NFPA 1123.
2. The company performing the display shall be certified or qualified in the State of Florida.
3. Copies of the following shall be submitted to Nassau County Fire Prevention Office no later than (fifteen) 15 days prior to the event.
 - A. Date and approximate time of display.
 - B. A listing of the fireworks to be displayed.
 - C. Copy of the Shooter's qualifications and certificate of insurance.
 - D. A diagram showing the area in which the fireworks will be displayed and the audience area, also the storage area with the proper separation distances.
 - E. Copy of all information shall be submitted to the Nassau County Sheriff's Department. Their fax number is (904) 225-0443.
 - F. Displays shall end by 10:00 p.m., with exception to New Year's Eve.

At any time if the Fire Department or Sheriff's Department determines that the display is unsafe for any reason, that official has the authority to halt the display immediately.
