- This Apprenticeship Program is being put in place to give current and future employees a definitive career path.
- Experienced operators who participate in this program may be eligible for accelerated advancement.
- This program also allows for a potential 24% pay increase from start to graduation.

The hourly rate for this position is \$16.0459. The County provides a comprehensive benefits program and participates in the Florida Retirement System (FRS) and has a 3% employee contribution requirement. Voluntary supplemental 457(b) deferred compensation retirement is also available.
